Terms & Conditions – Aerobatic Flight Experience

1. Payment & Booking

The aerobatic flight experience fee is **\$400 USD**. Full payment is required in advance to reserve the experience. Flight dates and times are subject to aircraft availability, weather, and pilot scheduling and are confirmed separately.

2. Participant Eligibility & Health

Participants must be in good physical and mental health. Aerobatic flight involves rapid altitude changes, positive and negative G-forces, and unusual aircraft attitudes. Individuals with heart conditions, back or neck injuries, neurological conditions, recent surgery, pregnancy, or any condition that could be affected by aerobatic flight should not participate. Participants confirm they are not under the influence of alcohol, drugs, or impairing medications.

3. Weight, Size & Safety Requirements

Participants must meet all aircraft safety limits, including maximum weight and size restrictions, as determined by the aircraft and pilot. California Flying Adventures reserves the right to decline or cancel a flight if safety limits are exceeded.

4. Weather & Operational Conditions

All flights are subject to weather conditions, aircraft readiness, airspace restrictions, and pilot discretion, in accordance with FAA regulations. Flights canceled due to weather or operational reasons may be rescheduled or credited. Once a flight has begun, refunds are not available due to weather or operational changes.

5. Cancellations & No-Shows

Cancellations or rescheduling requests must be made at least 48 hours in advance. Late cancellations or failure to appear may result in forfeiture of payment. Refunds are not guaranteed and are issued at the sole discretion of California Flying Adventures.

6. Assumption of Risk

Aerobatic flight is an inherently risky aviation activity, even when conducted under FAA regulations and best safety practices. The participant knowingly and voluntarily assumes all risks, including discomfort, motion sickness, injury, or death.

7. Release of Liability

The participant agrees to release and hold harmless California Flying Adventures, the pilot, aircraft owner, airport authority, and affiliated parties from claims arising out of participation, except where prohibited by law. A separate FAA-compliant liability waiver may be required prior to flight.

8. Pilot Authority

The pilot in command has final authority over all aspects of the flight under FAA regulations, including maneuvers performed, flight duration, and early termination of the flight for safety, weather, or passenger comfort without refund.

9. Photography & Media

Photos and videos may be taken on the ground only, at the discretion of California Flying Adventures. In-flight photography or video by passengers is not permitted due to the hazard posed by loose items in the cockpit during

aerobatic maneuvers. In-flight video may be available for purchase when provided by California Flying Adventures using approved, securely mounted equipment that meets FAA safety standards. Personal cameras, phones, or loose recording devices are strictly prohibited during flight.

10. Gift Certificates & Transfers

Gift certificates are non-refundable. Transfers may be permitted with prior approval and are subject to eligibility and safety requirements. Certificates may expire if not redeemed within the stated timeframe.

11. Governing Law

These Terms and Conditions are governed by the laws of the State of California, without regard to conflict-of-law principles.

12. Acceptance

By submitting payment, the participant acknowledges they have read, understood, and agreed to these Terms and Conditions and understand the nature of aerobatic flight.
